Annual Review

58th Annual General Meeting

October 23, 2023

Dear Members/ Colleagues,

On behalf of members of the Executive Committee and myself, I welcome all the participants at the 58th Annual General Meeting for the sugar year ended September 30, 2023. I am grateful to Allah (SWT) who provided me an opportunity to lead the Association at such juncture when it was passing through difficult times. I have tried my level best to project the view point of PSMA effectively and forcefully which was only possible with your unflinching support. I feel privileged to have worked with such an experienced team. It was with your cooperation that we faced various challenges and overcome those successfully.

Now I will present the Annual Review for the year ended on 30th September, 2023.

Area Under Sugarcane Cultivation and Production of Sugar

The year under review had many ups and downs. Area under cultivation of Sugarcane crop in 2021-22 was 1,259,594 hectares which in 2022-23 increased by about 4.6% but surprisingly sugarcane production almost remained the same. In Punjab province, area under sugarcane cultivation and production of cane crop increased by 7.9% and 4.2 % respectively whereas in Sindh, area under cultivation reduced by about 2% whereas production of sugarcane crop suffered badly

and dropped by 16.9% mainly due to massive floods which played havoc with the crop. In Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province, area and production of sugarcane crop decreased by 4.58% and 1.34% respectively. Besides heavy floods in Sindh, the growers of other provinces experienced low yield of sugarcane due to change in climatic conditions.

During this year, as per reports of Provincial Cane Commissioners, Cane crushing and sugar production in Punjab remained 17.5% and 13.2% respectively less than what was estimated, whereas in Sindh, Cane crushing and sugar production were around 24% less than estimation. However, in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Cane crushing and sugar production remained 16.9% and 20.76% respectively more than estimation.

The overall average sucrose recovery rate achieved on Pakistan basis this time was 10.19% which was higher than the preceding year's recovery rate of 9.87% because of start of crushing season during last week of November, 2022 as against Crushing Season 2021-22 when season was started in the 2nd week of November. Delay of 15 days resulted in increase of 32 basis points in sucrose recovery which caused increase in sugar production.

Sugar Stocks

Last year Sugarcane crushing started in the 2nd week of November, 2021. We started the year with a surplus of 990,048 tons of sugar. During the crushing season 2022-23, 6,740,663 tons of sugar was produced including 83,366 tons produced from beet. Out of which, 76,480 tons of sugar was lifted in the month of November, 2022 whereas

during the period of ten months i.e. from 1st December 2022 to 30th September 2023, 5,860,789 tons of sugar was lifted and consumed internally with average monthly consumption of 586,079. On the other hand, 247,500 tons of sugar was also exported with the approval of ECC during the year. Thus, remaining sugar availability in the country as of 30th September, 2023 was 1,545,941 tons which based on current lifting which has substantially reduced would be sufficient until Mid-January, 2024. On the other hand, the crushing is likely to start this year by end November. Therefore, sugar stocks are adequately available in the country until start of new crushing season.

Export of Sugar

Last year when the cane crushing started, the sugar stocks were available to the tune of 990,048 tons. In the first meeting of reconstituted Sugar Advisory Board, PSMA highlighted that since the international prices of sugar were higher than the domestic prices and the sugar stocks are surplus after meeting country's internal requirement, therefore, the Government may allow the industry to export surplus sugar so that foreign exchange could be earned for the country. On the insistence of PSMA, Government initially allowed export of sugar up to 100,000 MT and then 150,000 MT afterwards with too many conditions and considerable delays in the implementation of export procedures. As against total permission of 250,000 tons of sugar, actual export of 247,500 tons was made.

Sugar Price

From November 2022 to March 2023, the price of sugar remained depressed and most of the time even below cost. The industry sold sugar at losses to ensure timely payments to the sugarcane growers. However, from April onwards, sugar prices started showing upward trend which can be attributed to the following reasons:

- PSMA time and again requested the Government that only way to offset upward trend in price of sugar is to control enormous smuggling being carried out across the borders with Afghanistan. Since sugar is not an indigenous resource in Afghanistan and there is a huge gap between the price of sugar in Pakistan and Afghanistan, therefore smugglers feel attracted to the huge margins. It was further apprised that huge differential between international price (USD 646/ MT) and domestic price (USD 474/ MT) was much wider, hence attracting the smuggling of sugar. During various meetings of Sugar Advisory Board, PSMA emphasized the Federal Government to control smuggling of sugar. The matter was even highlighted in the meeting specially called by the Special Assistant to the Prime Minister to review the sugar availability in the country. Government has now taken action against smugglers and very successfully overcome this menace.
- Cost of production has increased considerably due to increase in Sugarcane support price, sales tax, minimum wages, markup rates, EOBI & SSC contributions and turn over taxes etc.

- Higher Sugar prices in the International Market
- Pak Rupee depreciation against USD remained phenomenal
- Substantial increase in Policy rate from 16% to 23%
- Inflation Rate increased from 26.6% to 31.4%
- Increase in Sales Tax from 17% to 18% in February, 2023.
- Raids on the sugar dealers virtually destroyed the local supply chain, thus creating sugar shortages leading to price hike without there being any factual shortage of the commodity.
- Price surge trend in other commodities has also influenced sugar prices.
- Restrictions imposed by the Govt of Punjab on Inter Provincial movement of sugar resulted in increase of sugar prices in various parts of KPK and Baluchistan. Restrictions were also imposed on transportation of sugar from Sindh to Punjab. The issue was even agitated in the meeting convened by Minister for Industries & Production who assured that some mechanism would be devised to resolve the matter.
- Rumors regarding import of 100,000 tons of sugar by the Government also played a major impact. Speculation regarding shortage of sugar in future contributed in increase of prices beyond the normal limits. There is no justification to apprehend shortage when adequate sugar stocks are available in the country.

Issues Raised by PSMA Before Various Forums

- A. Sugar is the only consumable item from Agriculture produce on which Govt charges 18% sales tax whereas there is no sales tax on other consumable items like rice, wheat, flour, maize, vegetables and fruits. This issue needs to be addressed.
- B. Although Sugarcane Research Departments have been established by the Government however, no effective work has been done on improvement of sugarcane yield per acre and introduction of new varieties.
- C. It has been stressed that there is no linkage in price fixation of sugarcane and sugar. Although this issue has been highlighted and agitated persistently in various meetings with Govt functionaries but nothing substantial could be done on this count. This price imbalance is causing multifarious problems for the industry.
- D. It has also been highlighted that Sugarcane processing spell is seasonal, sugar is produced on an average in about 100 – 120 days whereas sale of sugar is spread throughout the year. Mill owners are bound under the law to make payments to the farmers within a period of 15 days from the receipt of sugarcane.

Future Scenario

As per first estimates for the year 2023-24, area utilized for sugarcane crop is less than that of last year. Likewise, sugarcane production will also be less. Thus, there would be less sugar production. Sindh Government has recently notified the support price of sugarcane as Rs.425 per 40 kg for upcoming crushing season 2023-24 whereas last year support price was Rs 302 per 40 kg. Similar price is likely to be announced by other provinces i.e. Punjab & KPK.

It is expected that Cost of production will substantially increase for crushing season 2023-24 i.e. approximately Rs.50 to 60 per kg more than that of last year. Coming year's higher cost is also impacting the current sugar prices. In simple words, it can be assumed that prices of existing sugar stocks are adjusting themselves at next year's costing.

Recommendations Put Forth By PSMA

- Govt may initiate process of dialogue with PSMA to develop a comprehensive policy regarding sugar industry based on actual ground realities. Govt has always aimed at regulating sugar industry which has not worked over the years and is a stumbling block in the growth of sugar industry. Complete deregulation of the sugar industry is the only way forward to bring efficiency in this sector with government's close monitoring to have checks on sales tax & income tax evasion, smuggling, hoardings and other malpractices, if any.

- Govt has recently increased the support price of Sugarcane to Rs 425 per 40 kg which seems to be justified keeping in view increase in prices of inputs like fertilizer, pesticide, cost of labor etc. However, there is every likelihood that sugarcane will be provided to the mills at higher rates by the farmers. In order to address this anomaly, PSMA has requested the Government to devise some mechanism whereby supply to the mills at fixed rate could be ensured.
- PSMA emphasized the need of maintaining strategic reserves of sugar of at least one million tons through Trading Corporation of Pakistan which will help in stabilizing the sugar prices. If provincial governments can maintain strategic reserves for wheat, then the Federal Government should also take lead on this count.
- Government may let the local sugar prices adjust through free trade mechanism in view of prevailing higher sugar prices in the international market and especially in the region. Any administrative coercive measures would be counterproductive in the long run.
- Crushing season 2023-24 should not commence before 30th November to avoid sugar production losses of 250k to 300k tons. Value of loss in USD is 210 million. If we start crushing early, less sugar will be produced. Considering short crop in the country next year, no need to crush premature sugarcane. Sugar stocks available are sufficient until end Mid-January, 2024 based on current pace of lifting and consumption.

- Unofficial ban on inter provincial movement of sugar may not be imposed. Sugar supply to deficient provinces i.e. KPK and Baluchistan is being restricted in the name of smuggling control. Resultantly people of these provinces are buying sugar at higher prices as compared to that of Sindh and Punjab.
- The existing level of sugar prices is financially unviable to start crushing during the month of November. Before industry plans to go into crushing, it should have dialogue with the Govt to create better working environment.

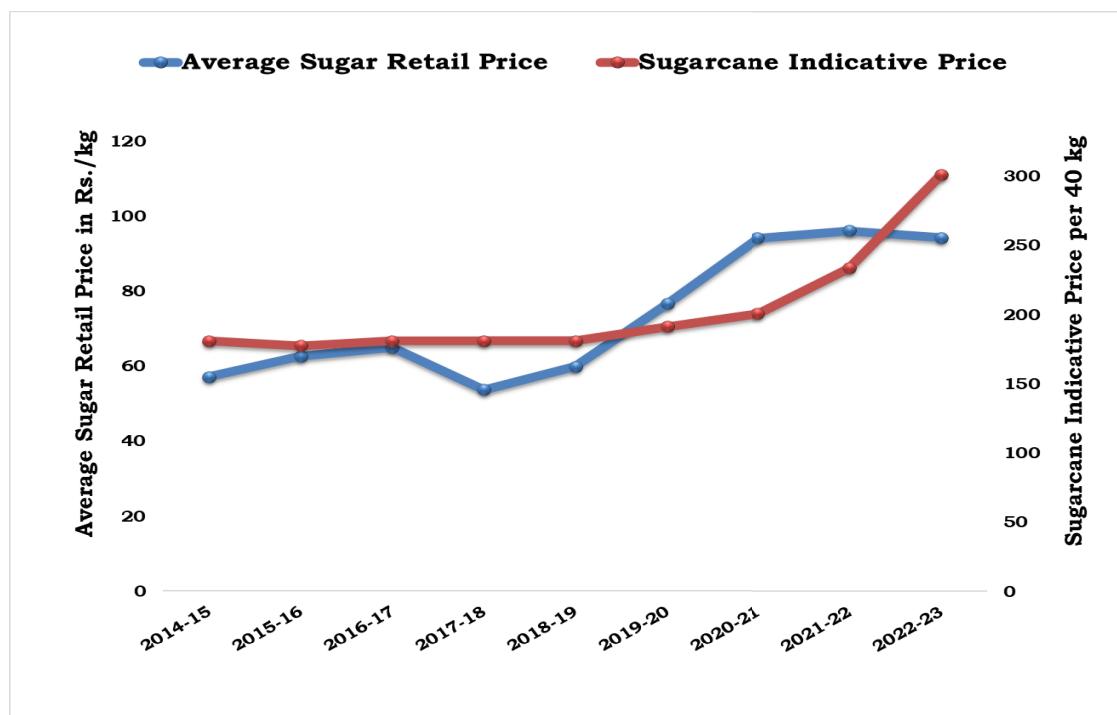

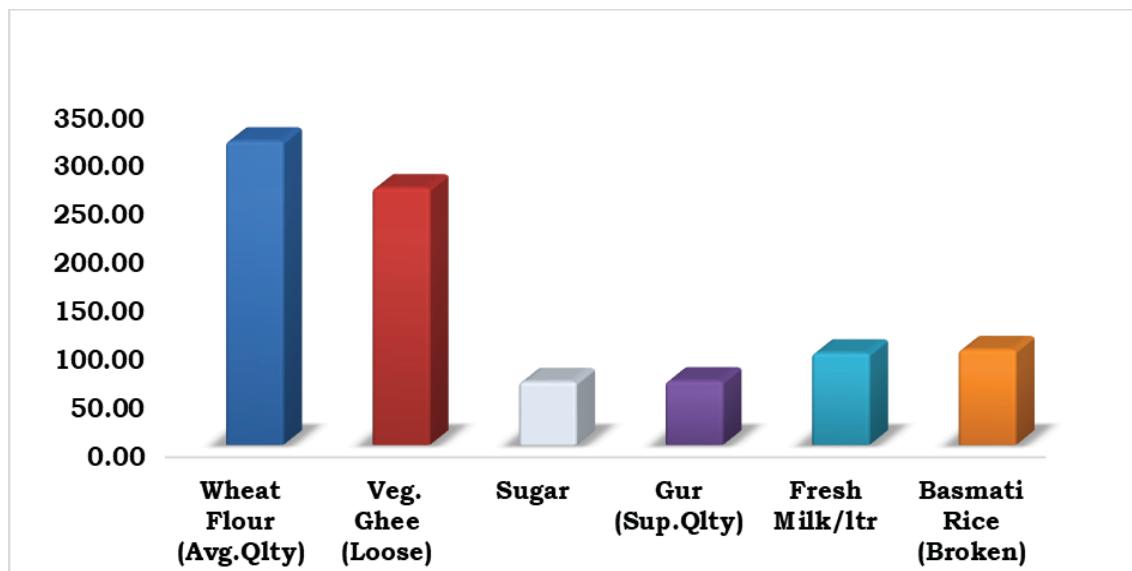

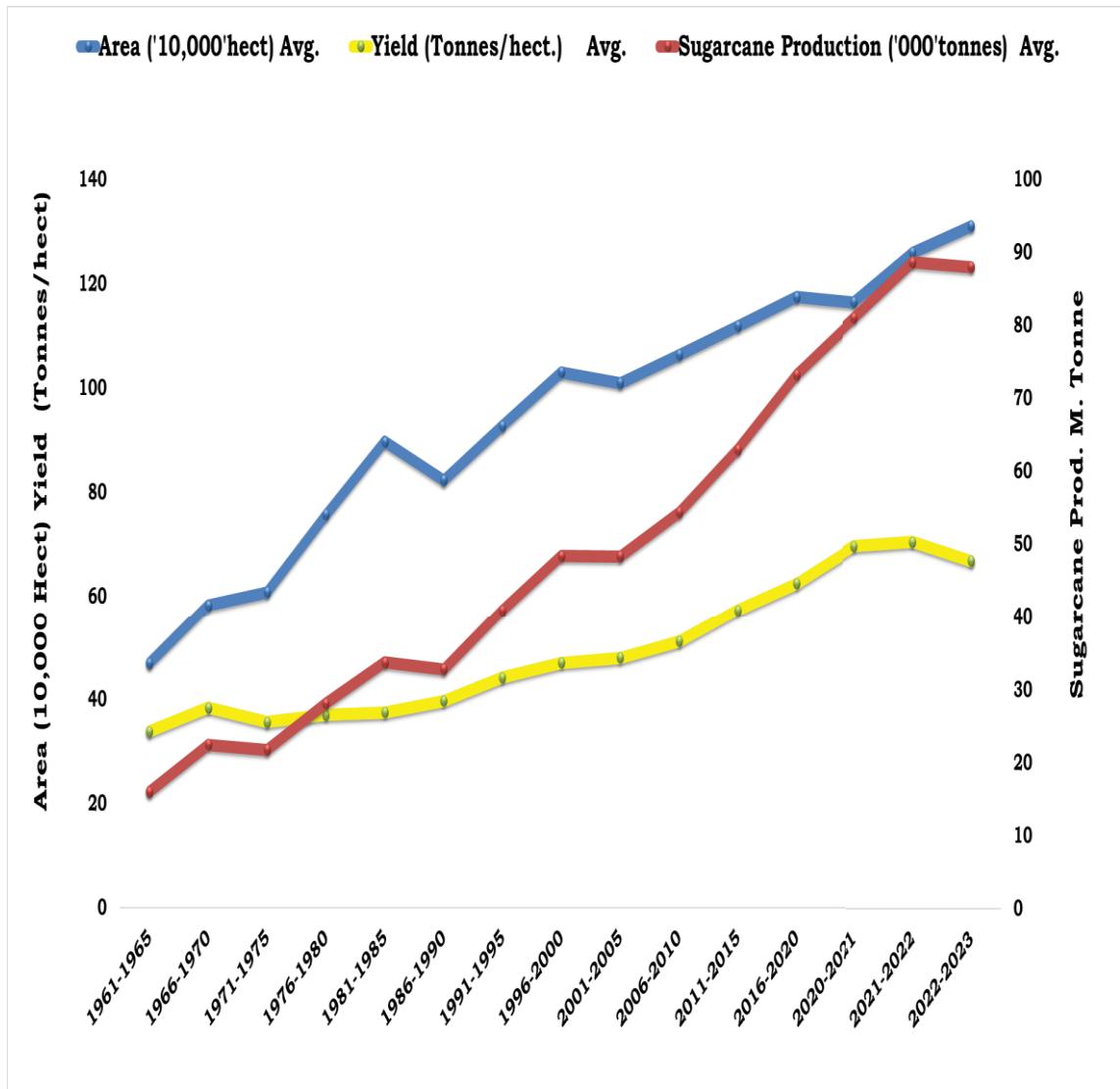

Sugar Consumption in Kg Per Capita

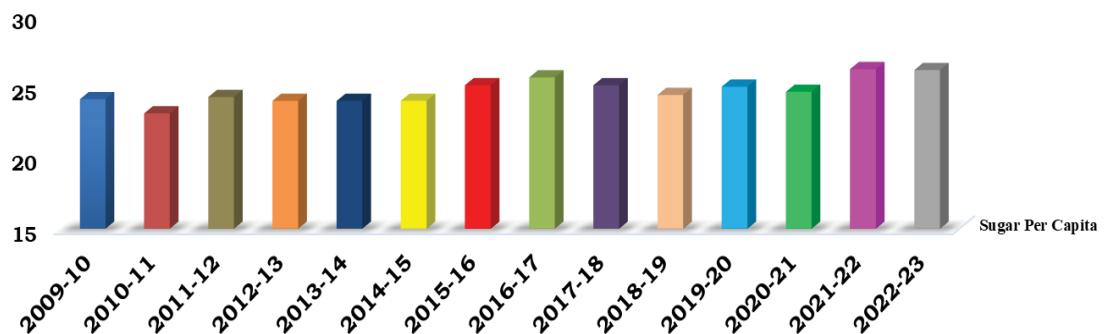
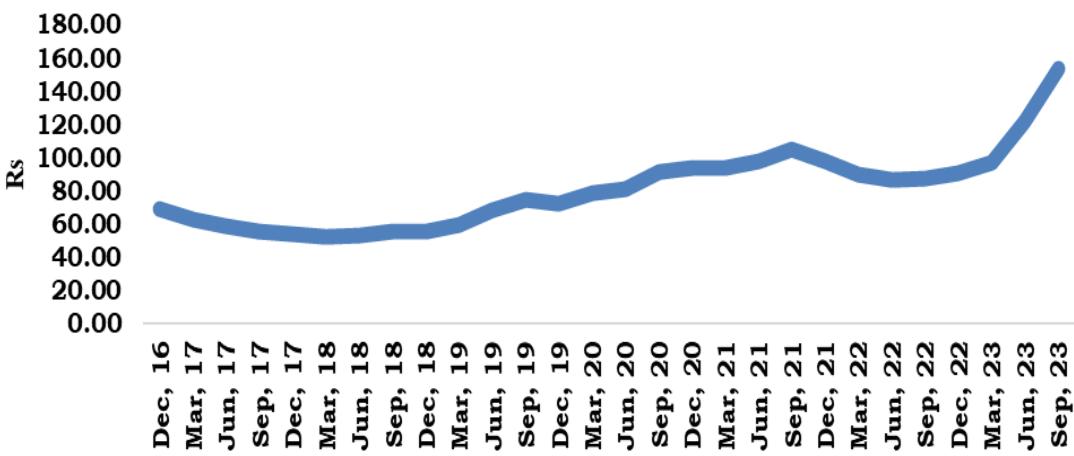

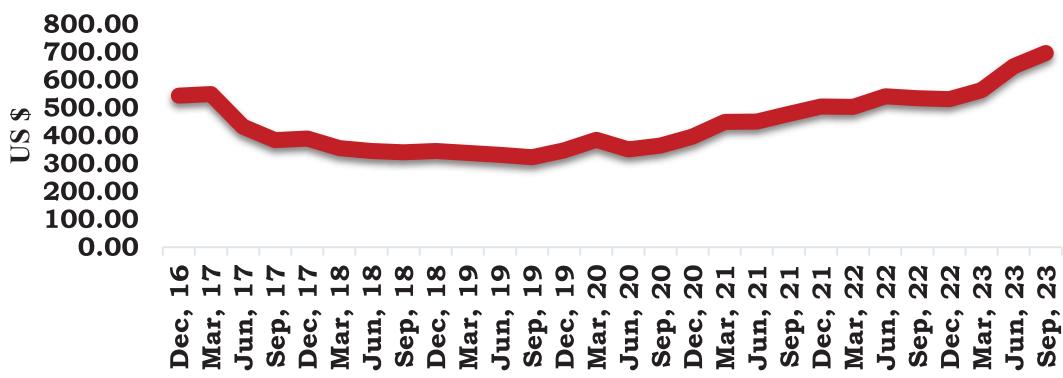

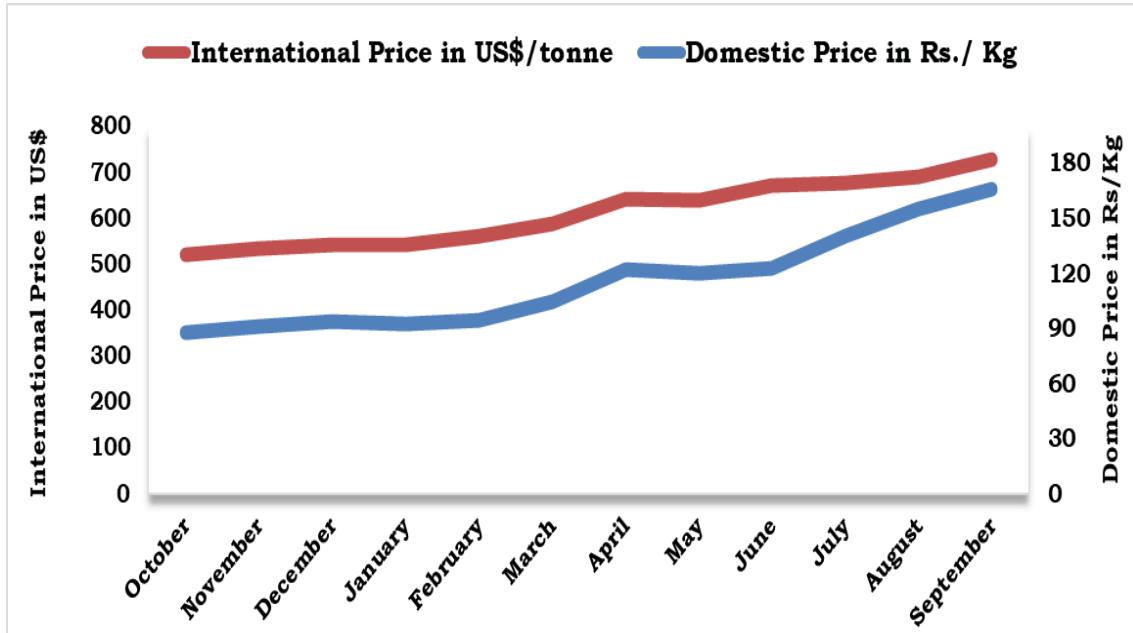
